In the small town of Cheyenne, North Dakota, Lottie Baldwin is an anomaly. She moved to Cheyenne from New York years ago to escape a rough break-up. Her only friend is Janet Larson – her college roommate and the reason she moved to North Dakota. But Lottie may never fit in because she serves as the stodgy town's resident psychic, Madame Carlotta.

When Janet's husband, Harry, goes missing, Lottie is determined to use her "gift" to help her friend.

Deputy Sheriff Harlan Erikson thinks that 1) Harry stumbled into something he shouldn't have and 2) Lottie should stay out of his investigation – that she's his girlfriend won't interfere with his job. But, one of the things Harlan loves about Lottie is she doesn't care for sitting on the sidelines.

Armed with her trusty deck of tarot cards, a strong will, and an impulsive nature, Lottie starts asking questions of her own – questions that might get her killed. She and Harlan must learn to work together if they want to track down the criminals, but the fatal fortune Lottie's cards predict might just be her own.

Paranormal mystery combines with a romantic sub-element to make *Fatal Fortune* an excellent intrigue and slightly madcap caper. Ms. Delisi knows how to keep her readers guessing. In Harlan and Lottie, the reader can delight in witty protagonists, although Lottie's impulsiveness occasionally borders on rash foolishness. Fortunately, the author's forthcoming titles, *Deadly Destiny* and *Perilous Prediction*, should bring back these interesting characters as they continue the Lottie Baldwin Mystery series.
